

# **Patrol Competition Rules**

## **Orange District 2011 Fall Camporee Camp Cherokee, Yanceyville, N. C.**

**November 4-6, 2011**

### **Patrol Camping and Cooking Demonstration Competition**

Points will be given in each category for a combined score. Each patrol will confer with its members to arrive at a single score.

Two members of the Patrol will remain in the campsite to give a presentation to the other Patrols as they come around to judge the Patrols.

#### **Camping**

1. Is the Campsite appropriate for the Camping Style being demonstrated? 10 pts max.
2. Is the Patrol campsite neat and clean? 5 pts max. 5 pts for very neat and clean. 0 pts for very messy.
3. Is the Patrol campsite identified? 10 pts for Patrol Flag, 5 pts for other identification. 0 pts for none.
4. Are the tents appropriately grouped by patrol? 5 pts for unified appearance, 0 pts for totally scattered or intermixed with other patrols.
5. Is the trash properly stored or disposed of? 5 pts max.
6. Is the duty roster clearly posted? 5 pts for yes and easy to find and read. Lesser points for not easy to find or read. 0 points for not posted.
7. Is there a place to wash hands? 5 pts max.

8. Did the presentation cover the advantages and disadvantages of the camping style? 5 pts max
9. Bonus – Campsite improvements appropriate for the camping style. 10 pts.

## Cooking

1. Is the cooking appropriate for the style chosen? Use of only one pot for One Pot Cooking (desert can be in second pot). Dutch Oven is using Dutch Ovens or other Cast Iron pots. Tin foil is using only tin foil. Over the fire only uses the fire. Etc. 10 pts max.
2. Is the cooking area neat and clean? 5 pts max. 5 points for very neat and clean. 0 pts for very messy.
3. Is the menu clearly posted? 5 pts for yes easy to find and read. Lesser points for less easy to find or read. 0 pts for not posted.
4. Is the food neatly and safely stored? 5 pts max.
5. Is there a designated cleanup/dishwashing area? 5 pts max.
6. Does the menu have a balance of the 4 food groups (fruits, vegetables, grains(starches) and protein)? 10 pts max.
7. Is there an area for the Patrol to eat together as a group? 5 pts max.
8. Was the presentation well thought out and presented. Did it cover how the food was prepared? Did it cover the advantages and disadvantages of the cooking style. 5 pts max.
9. Bonus - Is the menu interesting? 10 pts max for interesting foods and complete menu (Protein, vegetables, bread or other starch, dessert). 0 pts for just Ramen Noodles and Pop Tarts.
